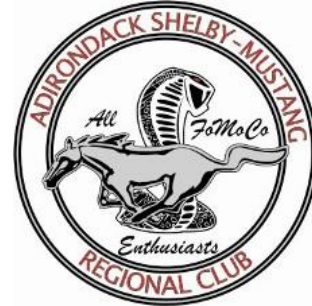

Meeting called to order By President Walt Dugan at 7:10 pm.

Old Business

- The minutes from the last meeting held August 2021 was approved. Ed Sindoni motioned to approve, and Ed Kepner seconded the motion.

- Walt passed around our cub mail. Walt discussed any e-mails he received.

- Steve Freed supplied the Treasurer's report for August 2021. The beginning balance was \$1,548.78 and the ending balance is \$2,297.45. Bill Childs motioned to approve the Treasurers report and Ed Kepner second the motion.

- Metro Ford Show:
The number of cars that attended the show was lower than previous years. Our income was also down as the result of lower attendance. The food and 50/50 raffle did well considering the attendance numbers. Make-A-Wish also did extremely well with their raffle. The largest cost that undermined our revenue was the cost of the Port-A-Johns. We discussed rounding up the donation to Make-A-Wish to \$1,000.00. Make-A-wish donation will be finalized by year-end after reviewing our overall income level. We will have further Metro discussion at the next meeting.

- Christmas Dinner:
We may have to reduce or even eliminate the dinner cost subsidy to the members attending the dinner party. We will finalize this at our next meeting also.

- Any By-Law suggested changes from the membership are due in writing by the October meeting.

- It was mentioned that we may opt to eliminate our membership cards and completely stop mailing the Newsletter and going with strictly E-Mailing them.

- The Nomination Committee will have the officer nomination list for our vote to take place at our November meeting.

- Ed Sindoni said that any clothing can be customized or personalized by our new clothing vendor. Check with them to see what the extra cost will be.

New Business

- We will not be able to meet at the Halfmoon Town Hall for October and November. We will try to meet one more time at Pirates Hideout depending on the weather and permission from the owner. Walt said we can meet at his garage for both months to finish the year.

- September 30th is the last cruise night at Harbor House.

- Our Christmas dinner party is scheduled for December 3rd at Moscatiello's Restaurant on route 4 in Troy near Hudson Valley Community College.


